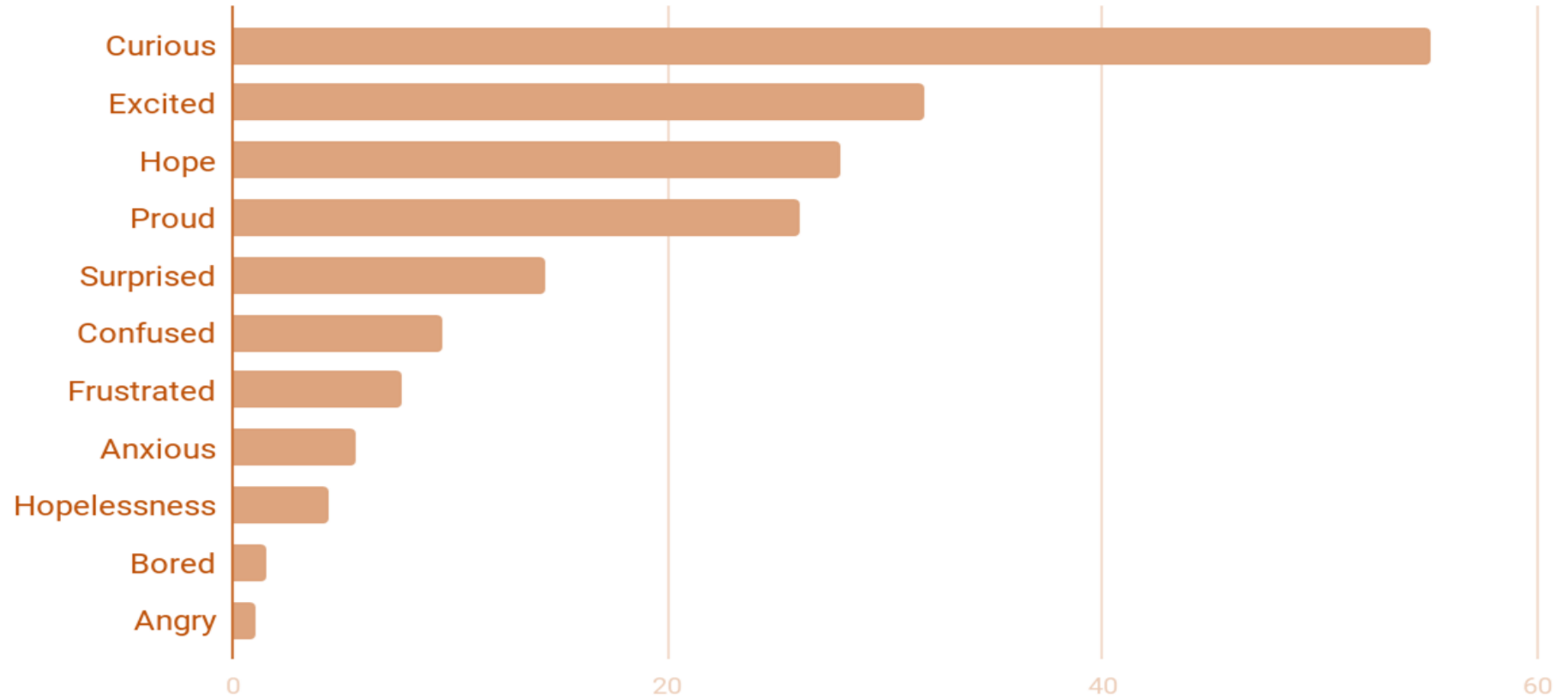

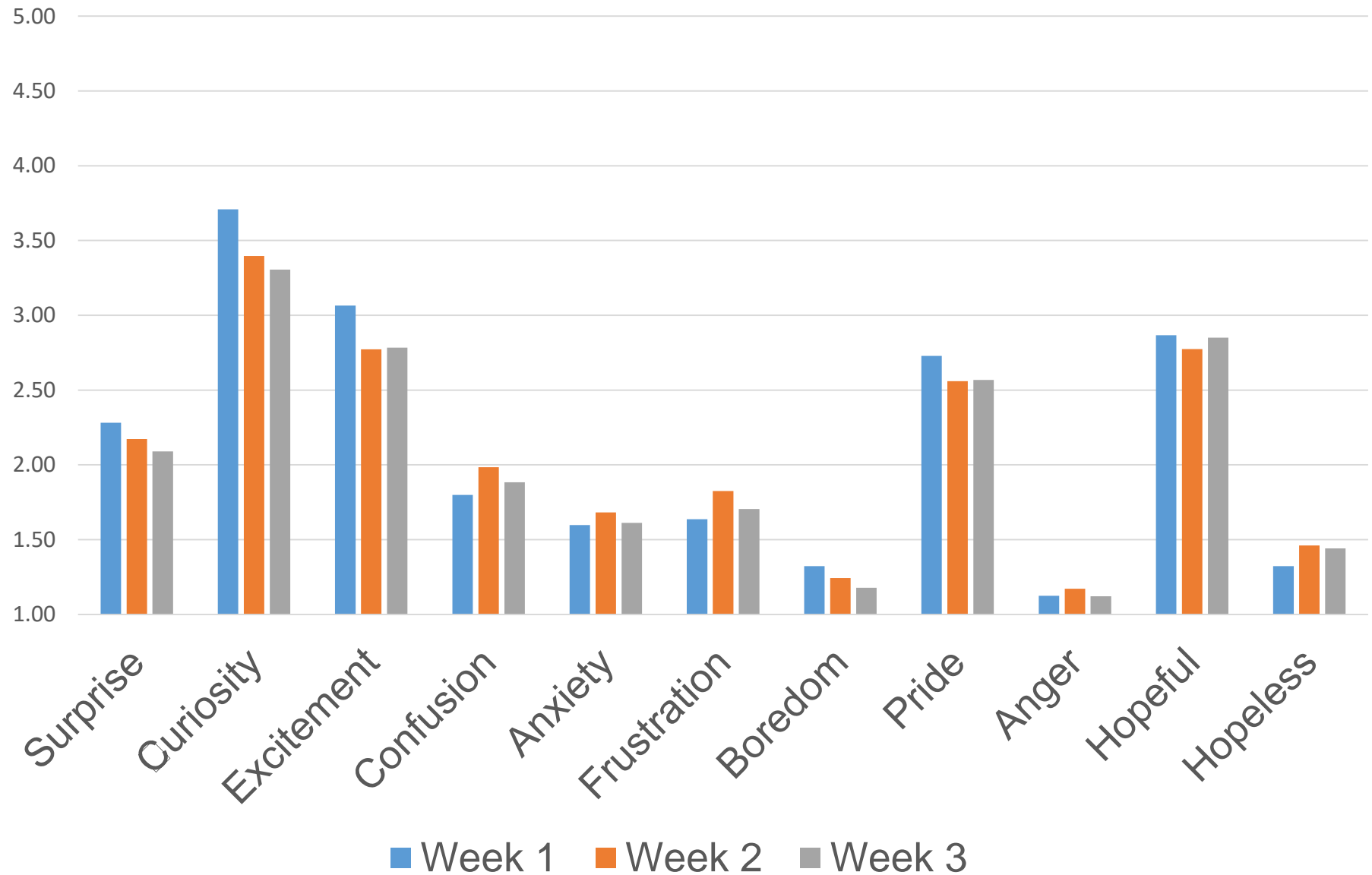

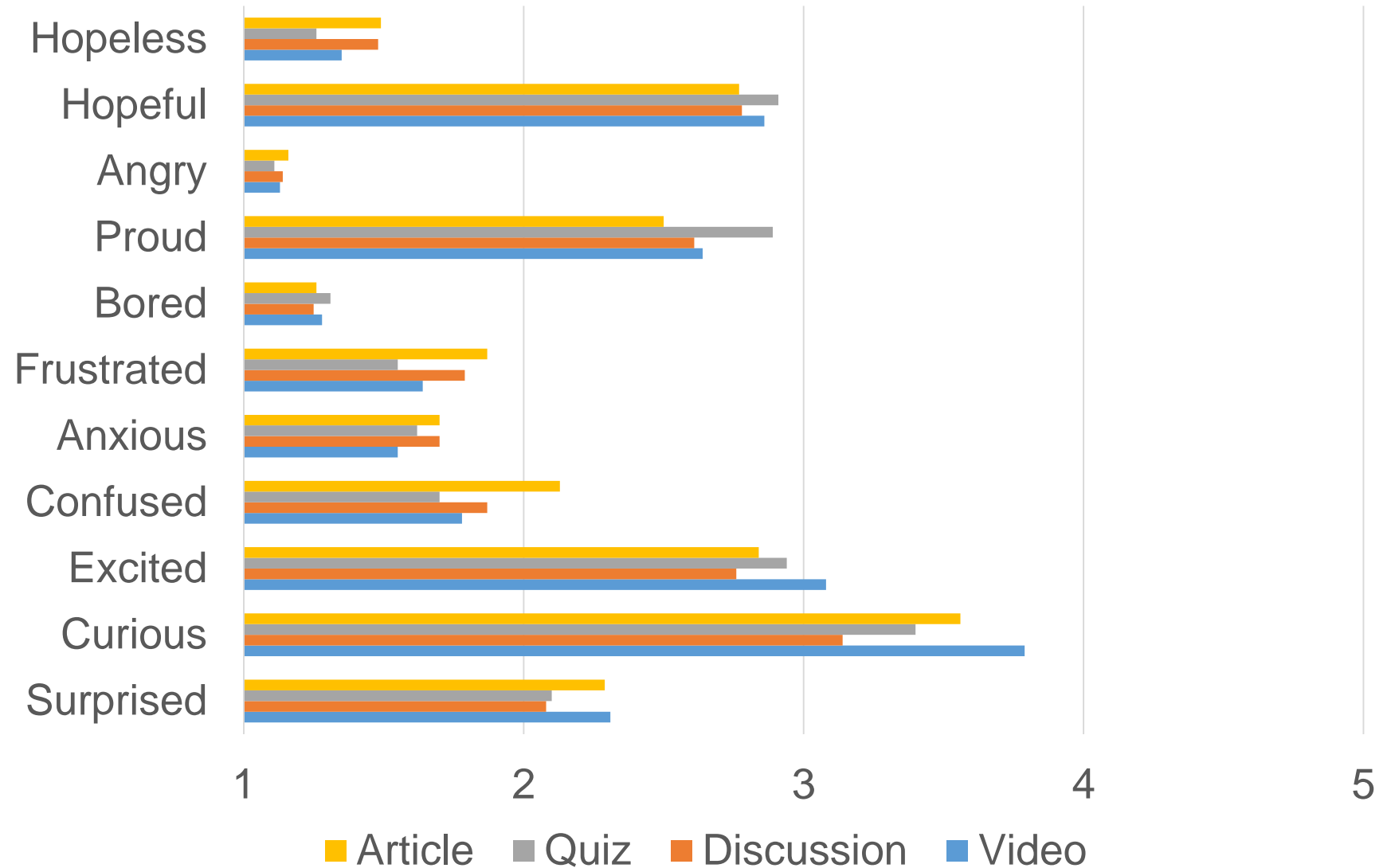
Mean Levels of Emotion in MOOCs



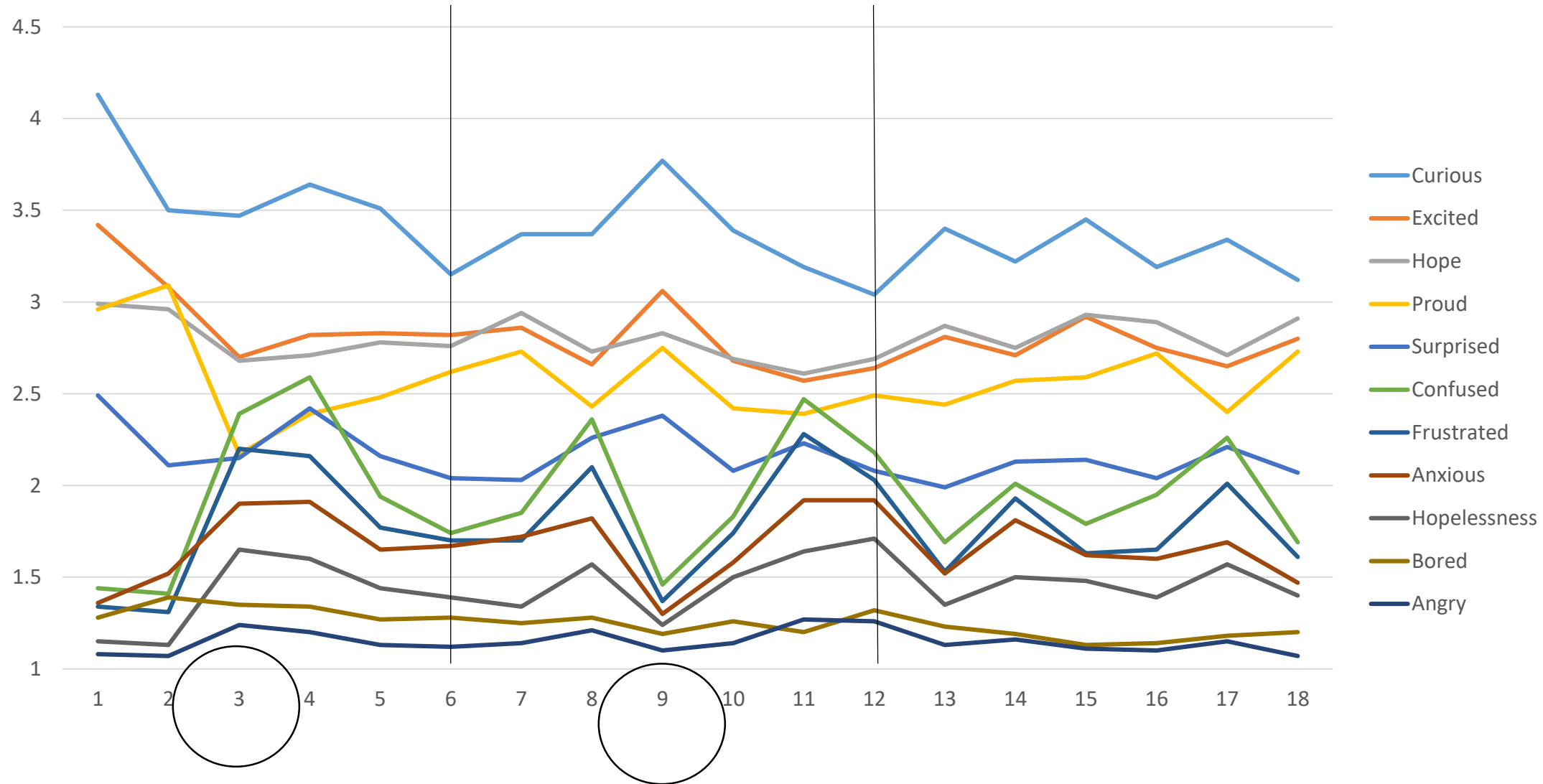

Step 2.22 Place names

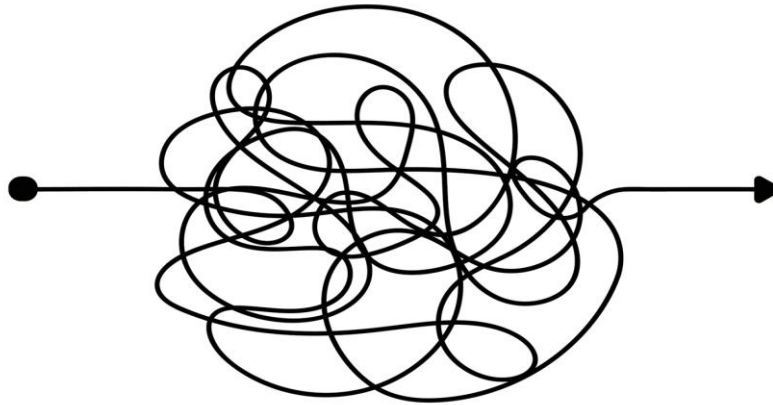
The Irish place names are quite fascinating as they have history and location built into them
